Points to Remember:

- Jump and Training completed in one day.**
- Harnessed to an experienced parachute instructor at all times.
- Jump from at least 10,000 feet – falling through the air at 120 mph!
- Ride the parachute to the ground, skydivers are taught how to steer onto the drop zone.
- Landing controlled by instructor.



Tandem Skydive Costs:

Each individual needs to raise a minimum of **£395** (£450 in Scotland and Northern Ireland) which is made up of three costs:

- £70 booking fee paid to Skyline at the time of booking.
- £170 - £250 jump cost (*varies between airfields*) this can be paid in cash on day of jump to the airfield, invoiced to the charity if participants raise money online or withheld from their sponsorship if they use a Do It For Charity sponsorship page.
- Once jump costs have been deducted the remaining funds will go directly to the charity. We advise that sponsorship is collected on an online donation page as this makes the process much easier for both the participants and the charity! However, if you have a participant who would prefer to raise funds offline then Skyline can collect this as a sponsorship cheque on the day on behalf of the charity. This can also be sent directly to the charity (but please do let us know when you receive this prior to the jump!)
- Anything raised above the £395 goes straight to the charity too!
